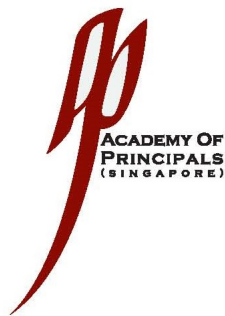
It was good to invite someone from the corporate side to share their perspective about change and how schools should prepare the students.
